



# Introduction: Why Pray for the Nations?

*“And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.”*

Matthew 24:14



God's heart beats for the nations. From the very beginning of Scripture to its final pages, we see His passionate desire to gather people from **every tribe, every language, and every nation** into His family.

Yet today, thousands of ethnic groups — representing billions of souls — still live with little or no access to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Being "unreached" doesn't simply mean being non-Christian. It means that within these groups:

- There are often **no churches**.
- **No Bibles** in their heart language.
- **No missionaries** living among them.
- **No clear witness** to the hope found in Christ.

Without outside help, they may live and die without ever hearing the good news.

## Why Prayer Matters

Prayer is not our last resort — it is our **first and greatest act of love and mission**. Before workers are sent, before hearts are opened, before the first seeds of faith are planted — there is prayer.

You may never set foot in a remote village or translate a single Bible verse. But through prayer, you can reach across oceans and mountains — straight into the hearts of the unreached.

*Praying for the Nations* is designed to make it simple and personal for you to pray intentionally and specifically for unreached people groups around the world.

- A continent-by-continent prayer journey, highlighting key unreached countries and peoples.

- A Prayer Commitment Tracker to help you stay engaged and encouraged.
- A legacy of hope – showing how God has been advancing His mission through ordinary, faithful people throughout history.

# How to Use This Guide

*“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”*

This guide is designed to help you pray more intentionally and effectively for the unreached peoples of the world.

You don't have to be a missionary or theologian — just someone willing to lift up bold prayers for those who have yet to hear the good news of Jesus.

Here's how to use this resource:

## 1. Set a Prayer Rhythm

Decide how often you want to pray through this guide:

- Daily
- A few times a week
- Weekly
- As the Lord leads

There's no wrong pace — consistency is what matters.

## 2. Pray by Continent and Country

The guide is organized alphabetically by continent, then country.

Each country highlights 2–3 unreached people groups, along with short prayer points to help focus your intercession.

You can pray through one country each day, one continent each week, or follow whatever pattern works best for you.

### **3. Use the Daily Prayer Prompts**

You'll find a set of simple prompts for each day of the week (e.g., praying for workers, open hearts, Scripture translation).

Feel free to blend the prompts with your prayers for the people groups listed.

### **4. Invite Others to Join You**

Prayer multiplies when shared.

Consider inviting your family, small group, or church to pray alongside you — one voice becomes many, and many voices reach heaven together.

### **5. Trust That God Is Moving**

Prayer is powerful, even when we can't see the results right away.

Trust that every prayer you lift is heard, treasured, and used by the Lord to prepare hearts and open doors among the nations.

This guide is not a checklist — it's a starting point for a life of bold, world-shaping prayer.

Your prayers matter.

Your voice matters.

And together, we move closer to the day when every nation will worship at the feet of Jesus.

# Daily Prayer Prompts

*“Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.”*  
Colossians 4:2



These simple daily prompts are designed to help you pray boldly, consistently, and specifically trusting that God will move powerfully in response.

## Monday: Pray for Workers

*“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few...”* Matthew 9:37–38

- Ask God to raise up faithful workers who will go to unreached people groups.
- Pray for boldness, provision, and protection for those already serving.

## Tuesday: Pray for Open Hearts

*“I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you...”* Ezekiel 36:26

- Pray for the hearts of unreached peoples to be softened to the message of Jesus.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to break down cultural, spiritual, and emotional barriers.

## Wednesday: Pray for Scripture Access

*“Faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.”* Romans 10:17

- Pray for translation work to be completed in every language.
- Ask God to provide resources — Bibles, audio recordings, gospel films — that will reach people in ways they can understand.

## Thursday: Pray for Divine Encounters

*"I was ready to be found by those who did not seek me."* Romans 10:20

- Pray for Jesus to reveal Himself through dreams, visions, and miraculous signs.
- Ask for supernatural encounters that lead people to seek the truth.

## Friday: Pray for Courageous Believers

*"Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God is with you..."* Joshua 1:9

- Pray for believers living among unreached peoples to have strength, wisdom, and boldness.
- Ask God to protect them and multiply their witness.

## Saturday: Pray for Strongholds to Be Broken

*"For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds."* 2 Corinthians 10:4

- Pray against false religions, fear, oppression, and anything that binds people from knowing Christ.
- Ask for freedom through the power of the Holy Spirit.

## Sunday: Pray for Whole Communities to Turn to Christ

*"All the nations...shall come and worship before you, O Lord."* Psalm 86:9

- Pray not just for individuals, but for families, tribes, and entire communities to come to faith.
- Ask for movements of the gospel that ripple outward across regions and generations.

# AFRICA

*“May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face to shine upon us, that your way may be known on earth, your saving power among all nations.”*

Psalm 67:1-2

## Algeria

### Arabized Berbers

- Once vibrant with early Christianity, the Arabized Berbers today are deeply Muslim and have limited exposure to the gospel.

**Pray:** Ask God to soften hearts hardened by centuries of tradition and send workers filled with love and boldness.

### Chaoui Berbers

- Living mainly in the Aurès Mountains, the Chaoui maintain strong Islamic practices with very few known believers.

**Pray:** Pray for visions and dreams of Jesus among the Chaoui people, and for new believers to rise up as leaders.

## Chad

### Maba

- The Maba people are traditionally Muslim and largely isolated from any Christian influence.

**Pray:** Pray for open doors for the Word of God to be shared in culturally sensitive ways.

### Tama

- A small tribal Muslim group with virtually no known Christians among them.

**Pray:** Pray for laborers to go into this ripe but unreached harvest field, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

## Ethiopia

### Oromo (Borana subgroup)

- While Ethiopia has a rich Christian history, the Borana Oromo people remain mostly Muslim and animist.  
**Pray:** Ask the Lord to break spiritual strongholds and birth vibrant churches among the Borana.

### Somali (in Ethiopia)

- Sharing culture with their Somali neighbors across the border, they are highly resistant to outside religious influences.  
**Pray:** Pray for courage for believers attempting to share Christ and for miraculous encounters with Jesus.

## Mali

### Soninke

- An influential Muslim ethnic group with strong historical ties to West African trade empires.  
**Pray:** Pray for the Soninke to find their true riches in Christ and for entire communities to come to faith together.

### Bambara

- The largest people group in Mali, deeply tied to Islam yet often mixing traditional beliefs.  
**Pray:** Pray for spiritual awakening and for Scripture access in their heart language.

## Nigeria

### Fulani

- A proud nomadic people spread across West Africa, traditionally Muslim and deeply resistant to Christianity.  
**Pray:** Pray for visions, dreams, and divine appointments to turn Fulani hearts toward Christ the Good Shepherd.

## Kanuri

- Concentrated in northeastern Nigeria, the Kanuri are historically tied to the spread of Islam in the region.

**Pray:** Pray for gospel radio broadcasts and oral Bible storytelling to penetrate Kanuri communities.

## Hausa

- Numbering over 40 million, the Hausa are one of Africa's largest Muslim-majority groups.

**Pray:** Pray for house churches to multiply among the Hausa and for courageous witnesses to rise up.

## Did You Know?

Africa is home to over **1,000 distinct people groups** who are still considered unreached with the gospel.

While Christianity is growing rapidly in many African nations, **vast regions** — especially in North and West Africa — remain deeply rooted in Islam or traditional religions and have little to no access to a local church or the Bible.

**Your prayers are planting seeds of hope** across deserts, cities, and villages where the name of Jesus is still waiting to be heard.

## ASIA

*“Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.”*

Psalm 2:8



### Bangladesh

#### Shaikh

- The largest Muslim community in Bangladesh, culturally proud and deeply tied to Islamic traditions.  
**Pray:** Pray for whole households to encounter the love of Christ and courageously follow Him.

#### Rajbanshi

- Primarily Hindu and marginalized, the Rajbanshi have little access to the gospel or Scripture.  
**Pray:** Pray for translation efforts and for new churches to be planted among the Rajbanshi people.

### China

#### Hui

- A Muslim minority spread across China, the Hui often live without any gospel witness in their communities.  
**Pray:** Pray for Chinese believers to reach out in love to Hui neighbors and for openness to the gospel.

#### Tibetan

- Deeply entrenched in Tibetan Buddhism, the Tibetan people live in spiritual darkness and isolation.  
**Pray:** Pray for breakthroughs through dreams and visions of Christ, and for workers to live among them long-term.

## India

### Rajput

- Historically warriors, the Rajput are strongly Hindu and often resistant to change.  
**Pray:** Pray for humility and spiritual hunger to grow among Rajput families.

### Yadav (Hindu traditions)

- One of the largest Hindu castes, very few have come to know Christ.  
**Pray:** Pray for bold evangelists to share Christ lovingly among Yadav communities.

### Shaikh (Muslim background)

- A large Muslim group with little exposure to the Christian faith.  
**Pray:** Pray for Scripture access in heart languages and for Spirit-led encounters with Jesus.

## Indonesia

### Sunda

- The second largest ethnic group in Indonesia, primarily Muslim, with very few Christians.  
**Pray:** Pray for the Sunda to encounter the hope of Jesus through dreams, visions, and faithful witnesses.

### Madurese

- Fiercely loyal to Islam, the Madurese people often oppose Christian efforts.  
**Pray:** Pray for peacemakers to build bridges and for the Holy Spirit to soften resistant hearts.

## Pakistan

### Pashtun

- A proud, warrior people group known for hospitality but deeply resistant to Christianity.  
**Pray:** Pray for Jesus to be revealed through visions, and for families to come to faith together.

### Sindhi

- Culturally rich but spiritually dry, most Sindhi have little or no exposure to the gospel.  
**Pray:** Pray for new Scripture translations and for gospel movements among Sindhi villages.

## Did You Know?

**More than 80% of the world's unreached people groups live in Asia.**

Nations like India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, and Indonesia hold **billions of people** who have little or no exposure to the gospel.

**Your prayers reach across mountains, megacities, and villages — preparing hearts for the good news of Jesus Christ.**

# EUROPE

## France

### North African Immigrants (Algerian, Moroccan communities)

- Millions of immigrants from North Africa have brought Islam into secular France, often living in unreached urban neighborhoods.  
**Pray:** Pray for churches in France to intentionally reach their Muslim neighbors with Christ’s love and hospitality.

## Germany

### Turkish Diaspora

- Germany has the largest Turkish population outside Turkey, many of whom hold tightly to Islam and cultural traditions.  
**Pray:** Pray for Turkish families in Germany to encounter Jesus through Christian friendships, love, and the truth of the gospel.

## Russia

### Tatar

- A large Muslim ethnic group, historically linked to Islamic expansion into Russia; very few Tatars know Christ.  
**Pray:** Pray for bold witnesses among the Tatar and for Christian media to reach deep into their communities.

### Bashkir

- Muslim by tradition and nationality, they have very limited access to the gospel.  
**Pray:** Pray for Bashkir hearts to be softened and for the planting of churches.

## United Kingdom

### South Asian Muslims (Pakistani and Bangladeshi communities)

- Britain's large South Asian population includes many Muslim-majority communities where Jesus is not yet known.  
**Pray:** Pray for cross-cultural bridges to form and for faithful Christians to shine brightly in immigrant communities.

## Did You Know?

Europe, once the stronghold of Christianity, is now considered one of the most spiritually needy continents.

Due to **secularism, immigration, and post-Christian culture**, many European cities are now home to **millions of unreached people**, especially among immigrant and refugee communities.

**Your prayers breathe life into a continent where the gospel once thrived – and can flourish again.**

# LATIN AMERICA

*“Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!”*  
Psalm 96:3

## Argentina

### Mapuche (Indigenous Group)

- The Mapuche people of southern Argentina and Chile have often resisted Christianity, clinging to traditional beliefs and animistic practices.  
**Pray:** Pray for the light of Christ to break through and for faithful witnesses.

## Mexico

### Mixtec (Guerrero Region)

- Many Mixtec communities remain isolated, maintaining indigenous religions with little gospel exposure.  
**Pray:** Pray for missionaries to be sent into remote villages and for the translation of Scriptures into local Mixtec dialects.

### Zapotec Peoples

- While some Zapotec groups have heard the gospel, others in isolated regions still live without access to the good news.  
**Pray:** Pray for renewed efforts to reach the unreached Zapotec peoples with the hope and love of Christ.

## Peru

### Quechua (Isolated Mountain Groups)

- Although Christianity has touched many Quechua communities, isolated mountain villages often lack sound teaching and Scripture access.  
**Pray:** Pray for the gospel to be rooted deeply and for indigenous leaders to rise up.

## Did You Know?

While much of Latin America identifies as Christian, **many indigenous people groups** – hidden in jungles, mountains, and remote villages – have **never heard a clear presentation of the gospel**.

Some groups still **lack Scripture** in their native languages or access to vibrant, healthy churches.

**Your prayers are helping the gospel reach the forgotten corners of Latin America.**

## MIDDLE EAST

### Iran

#### Persian (Farsi Speakers)

- Though revival is happening underground, the majority of Persians still live without access to a visible Christian community.  
**Pray:** Pray for house churches to grow strong and courageous, and for Scripture to continue spreading despite persecution.

#### Kurdish People

- Divided across Iran, Iraq, Syria, and Turkey, the Kurds have long been resistant to outside influence, including Christianity.  
**Pray:** Pray for peace in Kurdish regions and for gospel workers to bring hope and healing through Christ.

### Iraq

#### Yazidis

- A small ethnic group practicing a unique, syncretistic religion, Yazidis are often deeply suspicious of outsiders.  
**Pray:** Pray for healing from generational trauma and for Yazidis to encounter Jesus as the true Savior.

#### Kurds (in Iraq)

- The Kurds of Iraq, while more open politically than in other nations, remain largely unreached spiritually.  
**Pray:** Pray for courageous Kurdish believers to rise up and share Christ among their own people.

## Saudi Arabia

### Najdi Arabs

- Considered the cultural heartland of Islam, Najdi Arabs are among the least reached people on earth.

**Pray:** Pray for supernatural dreams and visions to open hearts in the very birthplace of Islam.

### Hejaz Arabs

- Centered around the holy cities of Mecca and Medina, the Hejaz Arabs are culturally proud and spiritually closed.

**Pray:** Pray for barriers of pride and fear to crumble, and for seeds of truth to be planted through media and personal relationships.

## Syria

### Alawites

- An influential minority group, Alawites blend Islam with local folk beliefs and are resistant to Christian evangelism.

**Pray:** Pray for miraculous healings and acts of love to draw Alawite families toward Jesus.

### Kurds (in Syria)

- Syrian Kurds face political instability and isolation, making gospel access extremely difficult.

**Pray:** Pray for relief from conflict and for Christian workers to find creative ways to serve and witness among Syrian Kurds.

## Turkey

### Turks

- Though Turkey was once the cradle of early Christianity, modern Turks are largely Muslim and increasingly nationalistic.

**Pray:** Pray for spiritual hunger to rise and for young Turks to seek truth beyond tradition.

### Kurds (in Turkey)

- Marginalized both politically and socially, Kurdish groups in Turkey remain unreached and often isolated.

**Pray:** Pray for Kurdish house churches to multiply and for the Holy Spirit to move mightily among Kurdish families.

## Did You Know?

The Middle East is the **birthplace of Christianity** – yet today, it remains one of the **least-reached and most spiritually resistant** regions in the world.

Entire people groups live behind walls of religious tradition, fear, and political oppression – **but God is moving through dreams, visions, and courageous witnesses.**

**Your prayers break strongholds and prepare the way for the good news to be proclaimed where Jesus first walked.**

# A Brief History of Reaching the Unreached

*"For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea."*

Habakkuk 2:14



When Jesus gave the Great Commission to His followers (Matthew 28:18–20), it seemed impossible.

Small, ordinary people were charged with reaching the entire world. But across history, God's people have risen up — and **the gospel has spread farther than the first disciples could have imagined.**

Here's a glimpse of what God has done:

## Early Church Expansion (First 300 years)

- The gospel exploded from Jerusalem across the Roman Empire — despite persecution.
- By 300 A.D., Christianity had reached major cities across North Africa, Europe, and the Middle East.

## Global Mission Movements (1700s–1800s)

- **The Moravians** (in the 1700s) began one of the first global prayer and mission movements, sending missionaries across the world.
- **William Carey** ("The Father of Modern Missions") went to India in 1793, inspiring others to follow.
- The **Student Volunteer Movement** (late 1800s) mobilized thousands of young people for global missions under the motto:

*"The evangelization of the world in this generation."*

## Bible Translation Breakthroughs (1900s)

- Missionary pioneers like **Cameron Townsend** (Wycliffe Bible Translators) launched efforts to bring God's Word into every language.
- Bible translation, literacy efforts, and church planting spread across Asia, Africa, and Latin America.

## Modern Mission Focus (1970s–Today)

- In the 1970s, missiologists like **Ralph Winter** highlighted **unreached people groups** (not just nations, but ethnic groups).
- Prayer movements like **Operation World** and mission networks like **Joshua Project** formed to focus prayer and strategy.
- Today, the global church (not just the Western church!) is sending missionaries — from Brazil, Nigeria, South Korea, and beyond.

## The Hope Today

- The gospel is now present in every **country** on earth.
- **Thousands of unreached people groups** have been engaged through prayer, missions, and Scripture translation.
- **Technology** (Internet, apps, media) is carrying the gospel into places once impossible to reach.

## What This Means for Us

We stand on the shoulders of generations who believed that God's promises were true.

**The task is not finished — but the momentum is unstoppable.**

Through prayer, obedience, and bold faith, *we can be part of seeing the Great Commission fulfilled in our lifetime.*

## Closing Challenge: Join the Story
